# 620 TWO CABINS DRIVE

## DESCRIPTION

Ideally situated to take advantage of spectacular views, enhance privacy, and to provide maximum natural sunlight and passive solar gain, this home features rustic stonework, structural timber truss framing, large expanses of glass, handcrafted lighting and metal roof accents.

A grand flagstone-and-timber entry staircase leads to the home's interior spaces. A vaulted great room features authentic wood timber trusses, a wood ceiling, hand-hewn walnut floors and a massive masonry fireplace complete with custom hand-forged metal doors. A wall of windows showcases views of the hillside and the Keystone Ski Area.

Beyond a light-filled, three-story timber staircase is a sculptural rock-climbing wall. Double doors open into a library, complete with built-in cabinetry and a "secret" room.



Just beyond the generous kitchen space is a spectacular octagonal Hibachi room with forest views in every direction. A sports bar and recreation room provide entertainment, while a bunkroom offers plenty of room for guests. A private master bedroom wing with wraparound deck offers tranquil views of the adjacent National Forest.

## DIRECTIONS

From I-70, take Hwy. 9 north for approx. 2.1 miles to South Golden Eagle Road. Turn left and follow South Golden Eagle Road (name changes to Golden Eagle Road) for 1.1 miles to Two Cabins Drive. Follow to the end, about .8 miles. #620 is located just down the shared driveway.
